## Introduction

Among those who oppose public use of the Rocky Flats National Wildlife Refuge, there is great emphasis on two health surveys, one from 1981 and a second from 2016.

By contrast, post-Johnson work and the surveys by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) have not found unusual patterns of disease around or downwind of Rocky Flats. So we also review the Johnson work, later work about those living downwind of Rocky Flats, ongoing CDPHE reports. Finally, we examine and critique the 2016 Downwinders survey.
