David: I was recruited by Rockwell International in 1981. Memos from Ronald Reagan were on my desk regularly. My main responsibilities were engineering design and manufacturing of nuclear war heads. There were three separate manufacturing areas at Rocky Flats known as the 700 complex (Plutonium operations), 400 complex (Beryllium and depleted uranium operations), and 800 complex (stainless steel reservoirs). Rocky Flats had the largest inventory of weapons grade plutonium (code name Wind and Trunk: everything had code names in those days and I know many of them) in the entire nuclear weapons complex that included Y12 in Oakridge Tennessee. What you need to understand is that Rocky Flats had all the responsibility for producing fissile weapons while Oakridge produced America's fusion devices. If you wish know anything about the design, manufacturing or certification of processes and materials you will never meet anyone like me. I was not only an Authorized Classifier, but I was the Lead Engineer for all Category 2 software in the entire Nuclear Weapons Complex throughout America. This meant that my signature was required for all weapons hardware put in America's War Reggryes I had final approval of all analytic geometry used in Computer Aided



Design and Manufacturing. And, yes: I have held piece parts and final assemblies in my hands. When I am gone, there will be pieces of history gone forever.
